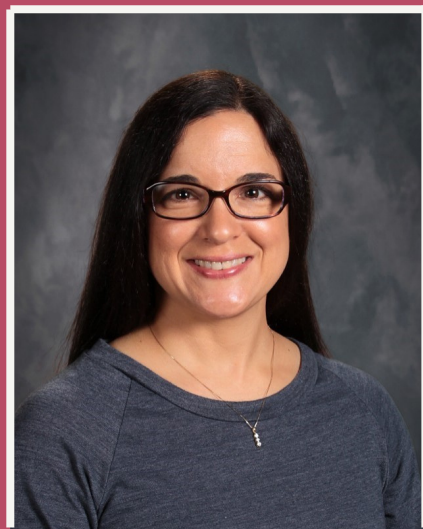
Jan/Feb. 2023 Newsletter Principal's Message

For K-8 students, SUSD is offering a free summer academic enrichment program from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM, Mondays through Thursdays, from June 5-June 29, 2023, at Wrightson Ridge School. The K-8th Grade Summer Enrichment Program tuition is paid this year through funds received from the ESSER III grant.

The robust summer program includes focused literacy and math instruction, as well as various enrichment opportunities in science, art, movement, and social-emotional learning.
