VIII. Superintendent Reports

The superintendent may present reports at this time.

- Dr. Valenzuela reviewed the enrollment report, showing that we are still up in our enrollment compared to this time last year.
- Dr. Valenzuela shared some photos from the Sopori Preschool end of year celebration. He said that this is a five star rated school.
- Dr. Valenzuela showed pictures from Engineering Day at Copper View Elementary. Mr. Goeden has reached out and has done cross grade level mentoring with his high school students. The students shared some of the engineering equipment with the elementary students.
- Dr. Valenzuela shared a photo of Ms. Post and some students who participated in the state math competition.
- Dr. Valenzuela also shared some photos of the Chamber of Commerce Awards Dinner for our students. The students were awarded scholarships. Best Western is one of the biggest supporters to make this event happen.

- Dr. Valenzuela mentioned that two students from Mrs. Gypton’s SeedSpot program participated in a contest. Two of our students came in first place and won \$5,000, they beat a group from Arizona State. They created a mobile for homeless people to get cleaned up.
- Two of our students placed first in Track and Field, Allen Williams from SHS who jumped 23 ½ ft., and Jada Pickney from Walden, won first place in state for 100 meter hurdles.
- Dr. Valenzuela shared photos from the SHS A+ Celebration.
- Dr. Valenzuela said thanks to Mr. Downs for his efforts of building the Retiree Celebration. Photos were shared from that celebration.
- Dr. Valenzuela also mentioned the Hall of Fame Celebration. This was a great event where FICO, Rancho Sahuarita, Nancy Kondrat and Jim Walker were honored.
- Dr. Valenzuela showed a news video regarding Ms. Ogas and student Riley from Anza Trail who saved one of student’s from choking. The student and Teacher’s Aide were presented with awards for Rural Metro.
- Dr. Valenzuela reminded everyone of our Middle School Promotions, Anza Trail will begin at 8:30 a.m., and Sahuarita Middle School will begin at 11:30 a.m. on May 17, 2016.
