### **AIMS Science – Spring 2020**

AIMS Science testing for Grades 4, 8, and High School must be administered during the testing window shown below.

	*There must be a break between sections when both test sections are scheduled on the same day.		

AIMS Science is not a timed test. A test session must be completed by the end of the school day.

Students taking the same test within the same school are not required to test on the same day.

Students in Grades 4 and 8 are administered two tests sections. Students are not required to take Section 1 and Section 2 on the same day. However, when two test sections are scheduled on the same day, there must be a break between sections.

High School students in Cohort 2022 (generally tenth-grade students) who did not participate in the Spring 2019 administration of AIMS HS Science are expected to participate. Students in cohort 2023 (generally ninth-grade students) who are enrolled in a life science course that is aligned to Strands 1-4 of the Arizona Academic Content Standard for Science at the high school level may participate in the Spring 2020 administration of AIMS HS Science.
