## Dear Parents/Guardians:

With the sudden school closure, we realize many students have medications that were left at school and we know how important these medications are to have at home. We have a plan to allow parents to come to one central location for curbside pickup of all of their children's medications. Unfortunately, because of prolonged statewide "Stay at Home" orders, we will only be able to hold ONE medication pickup location/time. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may cause.

Please note: ALL Student Medications must be picked up during the designated curbside medication pickup location and time, as outlined below. Any medications not picked up on April 8th MUST BE DISCARDED per our regular "end of the school year" medication disposal procedures.

We will not hold any student medications after the last medication pickup time.

**LOCATION:** SUSD Central Cafeteria which is located in the Sahuarita Middle School parking lot

area. This is the cafeteria that is utilized by students at SPS/SIS/SMS.

**DATE:** Wednesday, April 8, 2020

**TIME**: 12:00 pm - 2:00 pm

**HOW:** CURBSIDE PICKUP procedures are as follows.

- Please remain in your vehicle at all times.
- Please drive into the driveway for Sahuarita Middle School.
- Continue forward through the loop. The Central Cafeteria is the building located on the NORTH side of the parking lot.
- The first car should pull all the way forward in front of the curbside pickup area.
- A staff member will ask you for your child's first and last name, school, and grade level.
- Please show your Picture ID to verify your identity.
- All medications must be picked up by a legal parent or guardian.

## Parents living within the boundaries of Sopori Elementary:

We have arranged for all student medications for your children living within Sopori boundaries, but attending SMS/SHS, to be delivered to Sopori Elementary. Karen Salcido, Health Assistant at Sopori, will reach out to each of you to give you further instructions on how you can pick up your student medications.

Thank you for your patience in these trying times. We will work as quickly and efficiently as we can to get each of you home as quickly as possible. We wish you a safe and healthy end of the school year!
