### **Educational Format and Delivery**

Due to the ever-changing and fluid circumstances surrounding the landscape of education amid the pandemic, combined with the need to establish enrollment numbers and staffing in proper advance, we are remaining flexible with our educational format and delivery options. While our registration begins in February, classes will not begin until late May. Our goal and first priority will always be in-person education.

At this time, with so many unknowns, we are only able to ensure that Summer School will ultimately fall into one of three formats:

#### **Full In-Person**

In-person education is the most effective format and will always be our first priority. If we have reached a point of full return, certain measures will be retained as needed (masks, distancing, etc.).

#### **Hybrid**

Students who sign up for a classroom course will attend SHS in-person. Online courses will be taken through SUSD online Edgenuity program.

#### **Full Online**

Students would take their course(s) through SUSD online Edgenuity program.

It is the goal of our Summer School team to remain as flexible as possible while also providing clarity and direction to our students and parents. A decision regarding the final format of Summer School is likely to be made at some point in the middle of April. At that time, all students and parents will be notified via email regarding the educational delivery format for Summer School.

### **Attendance Procedures**

Sahuarita Unified School District is offering two semester, two and half-week semester courses at Sahuarita High School this summer. All students are welcome! Students may earn up to one credit by participating in both semesters. Attendance is critical in summer school. Students are permitted only one (1) absence per semester, no exceptions, regardless of whether excused or unexcused. Tardies are counted as absences at a rate of 3 tardies= 1 absence.

### **Fees & Information:**

**Tuition:** \$150 per semester

**Late Fee:** Additional \$50 if registration received after May 3, 2021.

Once you have filled out the Summer School registration, your account will be automatically billed. Payments can be made online (\$3 processing fee) or in person at your home high school. Please make checks payable to Sahuarita Unified School District 30.

Payments may be submitted to the front office to Carla Mariscal at Sahuarita High School or Engrid Pittenridge, at Walden Grove High School between 8:00 am - 3:00 pm until summer school begins.

### **Summer School Accommodations**

Due to the limited time schedule for summer school, instructional accommodations are limited to only those that can be implemented daily in the classroom. Extended time for completion of work cannot be honored due to the time constraint of summer school. Work must be completed within the established summer school schedule.

I understand refunds are permitted **only** in the event that S.U.S.D. #30 cancels a class and refunds will not be issued for any other reason.

I understand that if any of the information on this form is false, the student may be withdrawn from program.

I understand that all Sahuarita Unified School District policies are enforced during high school summer school.

I understand that **only one (1) absence is permitted per semester (regardless of excuse)** prior to being dropped from a semester class.

## STUDENT INFORMATION SHEET

2021 SUSD Summer School will be hosted at **Sahuarita High School**

9:30am Morning Break – Snack Bar provided, 11:30am-12pm Lunch break, lunch will be available for purchase daily. **Students are not permitted to go off campus for lunch.**

### ABSENCES & TARDIES

Students are permitted **ONE absence only** per semester, no exceptions. Students will be considered tardy if they are not present at the start of class at 7:30am. Tardies are counted as absences at a rate of 3 tardies=1 absence.

**Any student arriving after 7:45am, will be counted as absent for that day. Any student leaving class before 12:45pm will be counted as absent. Students withdrawn from summer school due to absences or tardies will not receive credit or a refund.** The Department of Education requires students to have a certain amount of seat time to earn their credit.

3 Tardies=1 Absence. Passes either tardy or absent will be given to students.

1 Absent + 1 Tardy= Drop from course.

4 Tardies= Drop from course.

### ONLINE COURSES

Students that have registered to take online summer school courses must still report to Sahuarita High School. Teachers will be present to help keep students on track for completion. Parents will be notified if student is not making satisfactory progress. Contact will be made by phone. Students must stay on task for their target completion date and must complete the course in its entirety by the end of each semester. Grading will be based on a whole number grade. There will be no rounding up of grades to the next letter grade (ie. A 79% will be the final grade of a C and will not be adjusted to a B). Students have the choice during each semester to retake assessments during class in order to attain a higher score.

### FOOD AND DRINK

Food or drinks are permitted in classrooms at teacher's discretion. Food and drink is not permitted in the computer lab or library, except bottled water.

### DISCIPLINE

The Sahuarita Unified School District policies and procedures are in effect throughout summer school. Discipline infractions will not be tolerated since summer school is a privilege, not a right. ***A student with habitual discipline infractions will be withdrawn from summer school and will not receive credit or a refund.*** If you have any questions, please contact Mr. Defazio at [jdefazio@sahuarita.net](mailto:jdefazio@sahuarita.net) or 625-3502, ext. 1827.

### PAYMENT AND REFUNDS

Payment **must** be made at the time of registration. Registration forms will **not** be accepted without payment in full. There will be **no** refunds issued. The only exception to this policy is if a class is canceled by SUSD.
