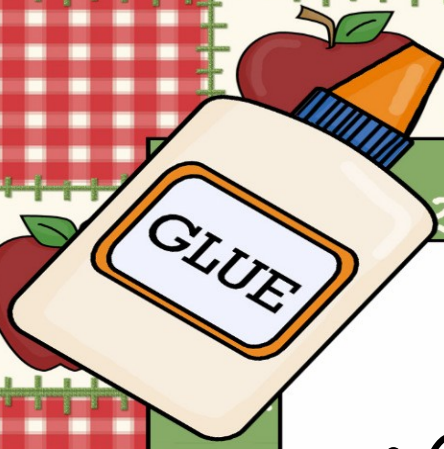
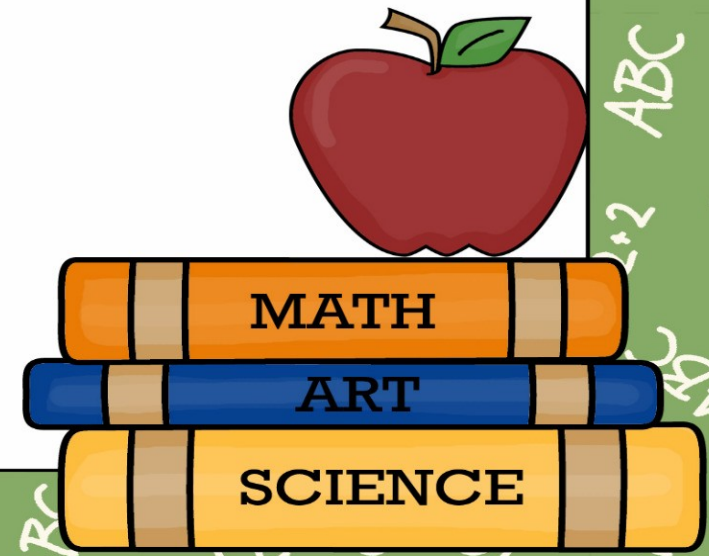

Coming to school in a vehicle

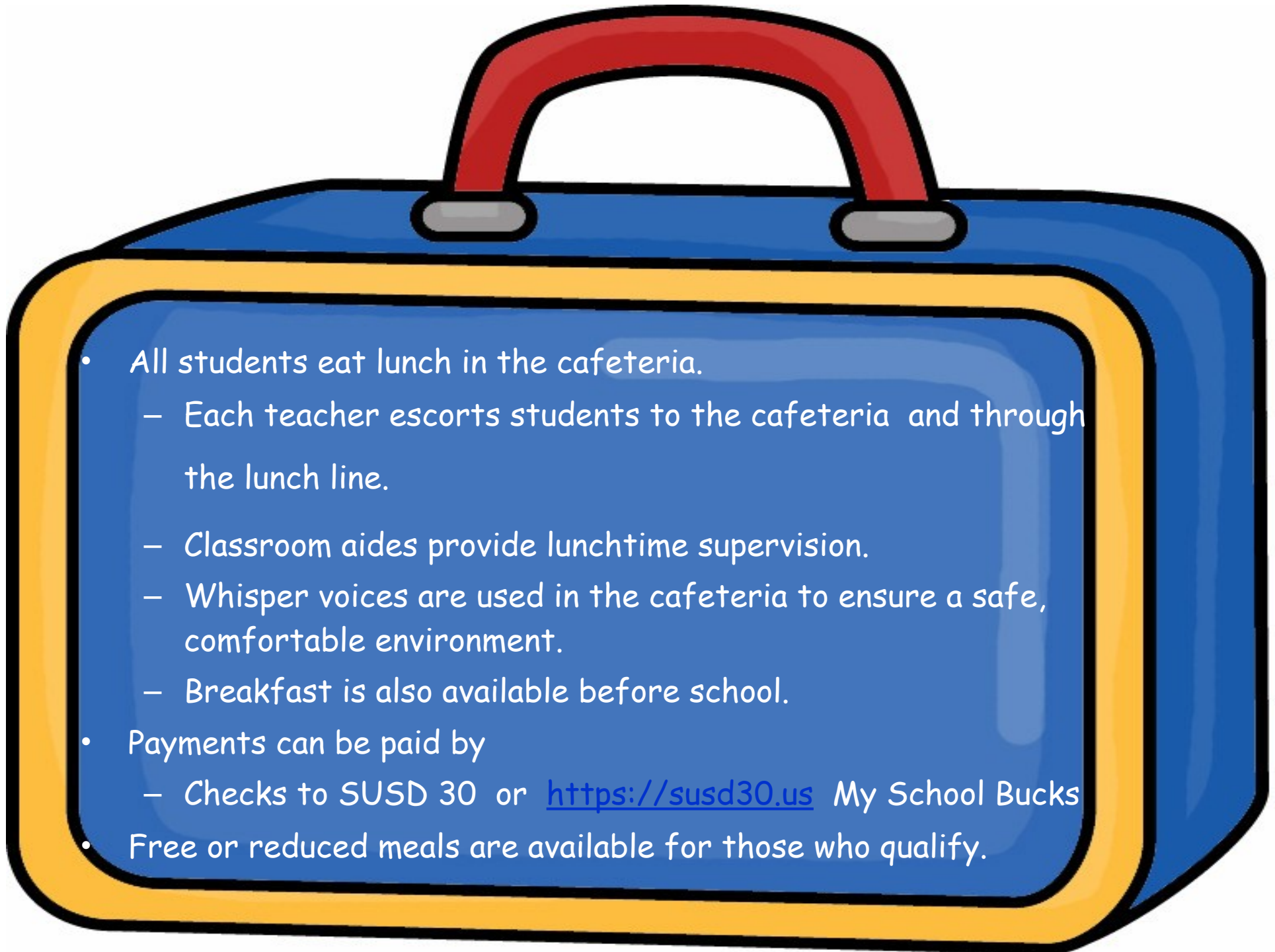
- Arrive at 6:50 but no later than 7:15
- Drive through drop-off happens in the East parking lot near the playgrounds.
- Students go directly to classroom.



Going Home

- If your student rides the bus home he/she must be met by an adult at the bus stop.
- Parent Pick-Up
 - Same as parent drop-off (East parking)
 - Have picture identification available
 - Anyone picking up your student must be listed on the registration form
- Transportation changes cannot be made by email or phone
- Emergency changes only
- As a school we require a set schedule for how you student will get home each day.





- All students eat lunch in the cafeteria.
 - Each teacher escorts students to the cafeteria and through the lunch line.
 - Classroom aides provide lunchtime supervision.
 - Whisper voices are used in the cafeteria to ensure a safe, comfortable environment.

- SOLID BLUE, WHITE, GRAY, TAN, OR RED SHIRTS
- MUST HAVE SLEEVES AND A COLLAR
- MUST BE NO LONGER THAN FINGERTIPS OR TUCKED IN
- PLAIN WITHOUT LOGOS OR INSIGNIAS
- MUST BE SHORTER THAN SHORTS & SKIRTS
- DISTRICT/ SCHOOL APPROVED SPIRIT SHIRTS MAY BE WORN



- TAN, NAVY BLUE, WHITE, GRAY OR BLACK PANTS, JEGGINGS, LEGGINGS, SHORTS, SKIRTS, OR DRESSES
- SKIRTS & DRESSES MUST BE LONGER THAN STUDENTS' FINGERTIPS
- SHORTS MUST BE LONGER THAN THE STUDENT'S THUMB TIPS
- PANTS & JEANS MUST BE FITTED, NO BAGGIES
- PANTS AND SHORTS MUST BE HEMMED

SHOES: MUST HAVE A BACK STRAP FOR SAFETY REASONS

- After 7:20 you and your child will need to check in to the office to receive a tardy slip.



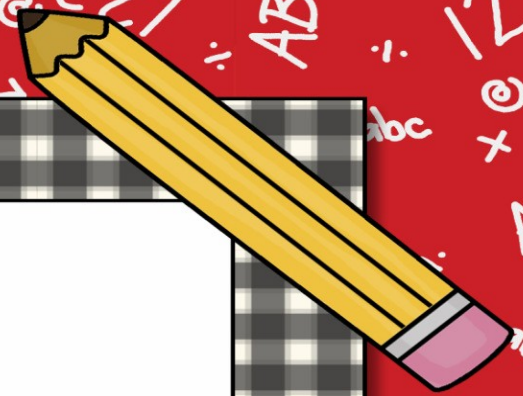
First Day of School
