

Riding the bus


- Routes are published during the summer

Coming to school in a vehicle

- Arrive at 6:50 but no later than 7:15
- Drive through drop-off happens in the East parking lot near the playgrounds.
- Students go directly to classroom.

Going Home

- If your student rides the bus home he/she <u>must</u> be met by an adult at the bus stop.
- Parent Pick-Up
 - Same as parent drop-off (East parking)
 - Have picture identification available
 - Anyone picking up your student <u>must</u> be listed on the registration form
- Transportation changes <u>cannot</u> be made by email or phone
- Emergency changes only
- As a school we require a set schedule for how you student will get home each day.



- All students eat lunch in the cafeteria.
 - Each teacher escorts students to the cafeteria and through the lunch line.
 - Classroom aides provide lunchtime supervision.
 - Whisper voices are used in the cafeteria to ensure a safe, comfortable environment.


- SOLID BLUE, WHITE, GRAY, TAN, OR RED SHIRTS

- DISTRICT/ SCHOOL APPROVED SPIRIT SHIRTS MAY BE WORN





