Thank you for your interest in applying for the Summer Work Program at the Country Fair White Elephant, Inc. of Green Valley!

This summer work program, sponsored by the Country Fair White Elephant of Green Valley (CFWE), allows Sahuarita Unified School District students the opportunity to experience the full gambit of applying and interviewing for employment. Each applicant must meet ALL of the following criteria:

- Students <u>must be available</u> for the <u>entire duration</u> of the program, which runs from June 6, 2022, through July 30, 2022;
- Students must be 14 years or older;
- Students must be fully vaccinated;
- Students must have their own transportation to and from work;
- Students must be available to work 3 days per week;
- Students must be flexible to work any shift;
- Students must be eligible to legally work in the United States.

Please note: The Country Fair White Elephant has made the decision to NOT ACCEPT any application from an applicant that is not available to work the ENTIRE timeframe of June 6, 2022 to July 30, 2022.

Interviews for open positions will be held after school towards the end of April in the conference room at the District Administration Office. If you are selected for an interview, you will receive follow up communication in regards to a specific interview date.

If this opportunity is one that you feel you'd be interested in, please complete the attached application packet, and submit it to my attention at the District Administration Office no later than 4:00 PM on Friday, April 15, 2022.
